Privacy Notice for Vendors

Amarin Corporations Public Company Limited and its Affiliated (collectively referred to as the “Company”) recognize the importance of protecting your personal data. In compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019), including its subordinate legislation and any related amendments, the Company has issued this Privacy Notice to inform you, as a vendor, of the purposes and details regarding the collection, use, disclosure, and transfer of your personal data (collectively referred to as the “processing”), as well as the Company’s responsibilities in relation to your personal data. The details are as follows:

**1. Whom does this Privacy Notice apply to?**

This Privacy Notice applies to you if you fall within any of the following categories:

- Vendor means any individual or juristic person, including a person or a group of persons acting as an authorized person, attorney-in-fact, representative, or person designated to act on behalf of such juristic person, who enters into a business relationship or contract with the Company as a vendor, including suppliers, sellers, service providers, lessors of buildings or premises, affiliated companies, joint venture companies, and any personnel or persons designated by the vendor to contact or coordinate with the Company for the purpose of or in connection with such business relationship or contract.

**2. Your Data Controller**

For the purposes of this Privacy Notice, the “Company” means one or more of the following legal entities, as applicable:

- 1) Amarin Corporations Public Company Limited
- 2) Amarin Television Company Limited
- 3) Amarin Book Center Company Limited
- 4) Amarin Omniverse Company Limited
- 5) AME Imaginative Company Limited
- 6) Affiliated company or legal entity established in the future

**3. Personal Data Processed by the Company**

The Company processes your personal data within the scope of this Privacy Notice. Such personal data includes information obtained directly from you and from other sources, as detailed below:

- 3.1 Personal Information, such as first name, surname, national identification card number, passport number, signature, date of birth, ID photo, and other similar information.

3.2 Contact Information, such as address, telephone number, email address, and other contact details.

- a. Personal data appearing in documents submitted for vendor registration and related transactions, such as documents for vendor appointments and requests for changes to the Approved Vendor List, copies of identification cards, copies of house registration, copies of powers of attorney, copies of company affidavits or certificates of incorporation, copies of VAT registration certificates (Phor.Phor.20), copies of bank account books, advertising orders, procurement and purchasing documents, tender or quotation documents, invoices, receipts, cash bills or substitute receipts, cheques and cheque stubs, payment vouchers, bank transfer confirmations, copies of professional or business licenses, and contracts.

3.3 Other Information, such as images and video recordings through photographic or recording devices, or through closed-circuit television (CCTV).

In this regard, the Company does not intend to process your sensitive personal data, such as religion and blood type appearing on your identification card. Therefore, the Company kindly requests that you cross out or conceal such information before submitting your documents to the Company. Otherwise, the Company may need to redact or conceal such information on your behalf in order to comply with the data minimization principle under the personal data protection laws.

#### 4. Methods of Collection of Personal Data

Where a vendor appoints one or more individuals to contact or coordinate with the Company, pursuant to applicable terms and conditions of the contractual relationship, whether as a seller, lessor of premises, service provider, representative, distributor, or otherwise, the Company may collect, use, or disclose the personal data of such individuals for the purposes set out in this Privacy Notice or in line with the terms and conditions of the relevant contract.

#### 5. Purposes of Processing Personal Data

The Company will process your personal data for the following purposes:

5.1 To use as information for vendor selection and procurement processes.	Contractual Basis
5.2 To prepare and perform contracts, such as purchase and sale agreements, service agreements, joint venture agreements, memorandum of agreements, non-disclosure agreements, and other types of agreements.	
5.3 To process disbursement or receipt of payments, including debt collection, and performance of contractual obligations.

5.4 To retain information as legal and financial evidence. 5.5 To comply with applicable laws and regulations, as well as rules, requirements, and guidelines issued by regulatory authorities.	Legal Obligation
5.6 To establish databases for vendors verification. 5.7 To monitor and maintain order, and to ensure the safety and security of individuals and the Company's property. 5.8 To present information regarding privileges, promotions, and marketing campaigns relating to the Company's products or services. 5.9 To deliver gifts or complimentary items. 5.10 To communicate for operating related transactions. **6. Retention Period of Personal Data**

The Company will retain your personal data throughout the period during which the contractual relationship between you and the Company remains in effect, and for a maximum period of ten (10) years after the termination of such relationship or your last contact with the Company for the purpose of exercising legal claims, unless any applicable laws require the Company to retain your personal data for a longer period.

**7. Disclosure of Personal Data**

The Company may disclose your personal data to the following persons or legal entities:

- 7.1 Persons or legal entities engaged in business activities for the purpose of purchase history, whereby the Company will disclose only the personal data necessary for such purposes.
- 7.2 Government authorities or regulatory agencies as required by applicable laws, regulations, notifications, or legal obligations, including but not limited to the Revenue Department, Social Security Office, Department of Business Development, Office of the Consumer Protection Board, Thai Industrial Standards Institute, Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission, Customs Department, Department of Employment, Department of Labour Protection and Welfare, Department of Skill Development, Department of Lands, Department of Provincial Administration, and other relevant authorities.
- 7.3 Other persons or entities having a business relationship with the Company, such as financial institutions, insurance companies, healthcare providers, securities companies, asset management companies, or other related parties, for the benefit and welfare of relevant persons and/or where such disclosure is beneficial to the data subject.
- 7.4 Professional service providers, including financial advisors, legal advisors, quality system consultants, external auditors, internal auditors, and other related professional advisors.

- 7.5 Providers of infrastructure and information technology services, data storage services, cloud service providers, and other related service providers.
- 7.6 Providers of marketing services, statistical data preparation, advertising, public relations, communication services, and other related service providers.
- 7.7 Any other persons or entities as required by law. Where the Company is required to disclose your personal data pursuant to applicable laws, regulations, governmental orders, orders of regulatory authorities, or judicial orders, the Company may disclose such personal data as required.
- 7.8 Assignees of the rights and/or duties from the Company: In case the Company wishes to assign its rights and duties, including entire or partial business transfer, merger, and shareholding reconstruction, the Company needs to disclose your Personal Data to the assignees (including potential assignees); whereas, the rights and duties of the assignees in respect to your Personal Data shall be subject to this Notice.

## **8. Cross-Border Transfer of Personal Data**

If the Company is required to transfer your personal data outside Thailand, the Company will implement appropriate safeguards to ensure that your personal data is protected at a standard equivalent to the personal data protection laws of Thailand.

## **9. Rights of Data Subjects**

- 9.1 Right to be informed:** Before or at the time the Company collects your personal data, you have the right to be informed of details regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal data, as detailed by the Company in this Notice
- 9.2 Right to access, request for copies, or to be disclosed how Personal Data is obtained:** You have the right to access and obtain a copy of your personal data. In addition, you may request that the Company disclose the source from which your personal data was obtained.
- 9.3 Right to object:** You have the right to object to the collection, use, or disclosure of your personal data where the Company relies on legitimate interests as the legal basis, or where your personal data is processed for direct marketing purposes or for scientific, historical, or statistical research.
- 9.4 Right to erasure, destruction, or restriction of use:** You have the right to request that the Company erase, destroy, restrict the use of, or anonymize their personal data held by the Company, if the data subject withdraws consent or objects to the collection, use, or disclosure of such personal data, or when such data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which consent was given, or where the Company fails to comply with applicable personal data protection laws.
- 9.5 Right to rectification:** You have the right to request that the Company correct your personal data to ensure it is accurate, up-to-date, complete, and not misleading.

**9.6 Right to withdraw consent:** You have the right to withdraw your consent for the collection, use, and disclosure of your personal data. However, withdrawal of such consent will not affect the lawfulness of the collection, use, or disclosure carried out prior to such withdrawal, nor will it affect processing based on other legal basis, including contractual bases, legal obligations, or legitimate interests. Please note that withdrawal of consent may prevent the Company from performing its contractual obligations with you as a vendor.

**9.7 Right to data portability:** You have the right to request that the Company transfer your personal data to you or to other data controllers, where such data is technically feasible, by submitting a written request through the channels specified by the Company.

**9.8 Right to lodge a complaint:** You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Company's Personal Data Protection Office in the first instance. If you are not satisfied, you may file a complaint with the competent authority where the processing of your data does not comply with personal data protection laws.

To exercise your rights, you acknowledge that your rights as a data subject described above are subject to limitations under applicable laws. The Company may refuse your request to exercise any such rights where the Company has lawful bases to do so in accordance with applicable laws.
